

## ***Who's my advisor? How do I schedule an appointment?***

1. **You have been assigned a regular faculty advisor based on the first letter of your last name, as listed below.** However, if you have another faculty advisor that you have been seeing for awhile, or whom you know well and are comfortable with, see them for advising.
2. **To schedule an advising appointment, contact a staff member (*Hattie, Maribel or Gwyn*) in the main psychology office at 617-373-3076, or go to 125 NI.**
3. If you need advice on a specialty program or other psychology offerings, contact the person listed below who is responsible for advising students on that program or activity.
4. If you have questions about your Core requirements, Transfer courses, or other College or University requirements, contact *Kim Irmiter*, the psychology advisor in the Dean's office of the CAS: 617-373-3980 or *k.irmiter@neu.edu*
5. If you have a special or unusual academic problem or need, ask for an appointment with one of the *Pool Advisors* when you contact a staff member in the psychology office.
